

Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule (RRP) Renovator Initial Training Lead-Based Paint Safe Work Practices

Attention all active Residential Endorsed Contractors and all house painters that are regulated by the RRP Rule in the Petersburg area!

Who Is Required to Have Lead Renovator Certification?

EPA's Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule (RRP Rule) requires that all companies (Firms) performing renovation, repair, and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, childcare facilities and pre-schools built before 1978 have their **firm certification** (company certified) by EPA, and use **certified renovators** who are trained by EPA-approved training providers and follow lead-safe work practices.

Tlingit Haida Regional Housing Authority is offering the RRP Renovator Initial training required to work on homes, child care facilities and pre-schools built before 1978. The course is also approved for Eight (8) Contact Hours needed for the Alaska's Construction Contractor Residential Endorsement.
